At this Craft Show, you only need one item... but you can offer as many items as you like. Other than your own production, using this outlet costs you the time and price of sending your goods to Lyn's Fiber to Fabric.

What we do:

The online storefront is prepared and hosted by Lyn's Fiber to Fabric. All web hosting, Domain Services, and Fees are paid for by Lyn's Fiber to Fabric. The website is built and maintained by Lyn's Fiber to Fabric. We will actively market the site and your crafted items. High quality photographs are taken and edited to highlight each item. Unsold goods will be stored per your instructions in a safe and clean area. Lyn's will serve each customer with diligence and efficiency. Sold items will be packed and shipped professionally, using cost effective methods to save customer expenses. We provide you with reports on a regular basis showing what items are being viewed and purchased the most. We will seek out the best home crafts and group and classify them carefully.

On Pricing Items

There are many schools of thought on the pricing of craft items and items sold over the Internet. First, you the crafter must set a value based on the expenses and time taken to manufacture your items. Some believe that a crafter's time is less valuable because they can work while enjoying television or during quiet times in the car or at work. We disagree with that school of thought. Lyn's Fiber to Fabric is a for profit enterprise. At this time the consignment fee is 20% of the items sale price be sure to consider this when you decide on your sale price. The final buyer pays shipping and handling fees. Pricing can also be reviewed based on sales and market changes. Don't hesitate to discuss pricing issues as you feel the need to do so.

How you want to be represented by Lyn's Fiber to Fabric is important. Your name or a business name can be used. Labeling for your products for a reasonable fee if requested can be arranged but is not necessary.

A Review of the Consignment Agreement

It is best to have all bases covered and spelled out for the benefit of all parties concerned. Lyn's Fiber to Fabric is committed to serving your needs as well as our customers. We work hard to insure that sellers and customers receive the best service and product. Please communicate any questions or problems that you have.

Before you hasten along to fill out the document and send your products to Lyn's Fiber to Fabric, please read and understand this completely.

Explanation of the Consignment Sales Agreement and Lyn's Fiber to Fabric processes

_____, referred to as SELLER, and Lyn's Fiber to Fabric, referred to as CONSIGNMENT MERCHANT, agree:

_____ consigns to Lyn's Fiber to Fabric the following goods:

Simply stated, you would be the seller. Please use your name or a business name that payment will be made to upon sale. Lyn's Fiber to Fabric (me/us) is the Consignment Merchant. This part of the agreement indicates that you are consigning items to Lyn's Fiber to Fabric. Below the statement above are lines in which you the seller should describe the merchandise fully. For Example:

Wool-Ease - Mittens - Grey and Blue 3 pairs, all adult sized
We do ask that you complete one form for each item, however if you have several items that are the same. Same size same fiber etc. Please do group them together.

Explanation of the Consignment Sales Agreement and Lyn's Fiber to Fabric processes

The title to the same shall remain at all times until a bona-fide sale in the owner of the consigned goods. OWNER may recall and take possession of the consigned property at any time.

This clearly states that while this agreement allows Lyn's Fiber to Fabric to sell your products you still own them and can request their return at any time. All products are to be in the possession of the hand of the Lyn's Fiber to Fabric at the time of sale unless otherwise agreed.

Explanation of the Consignment Sales Agreement and Lyn's Fiber to Fabric processes

CONSIGNMENT MERCHANT shall sell the goods consigned to it by SELLER at a price not below the following minimums, all sales being for cash or cash equivalents:

As compensation for sales made, CONSIGNMENT MERCHANT shall receive a commission of 20 % per sale.

This portion of the agreement defines the lowest sale price you will accept for your goods. All products will be sold at your lowest indicated price or more. Lyn's Fiber to Fabric will employ several methods to increase your income. Primarily when first posting an item for sale we might review your pricing. We might feel that your item will sell for a higher price or a lower price. No matter what price your product sells for you will receive the entire purchase price less 20% for the commission.

20% of total sale price not including Shipping Handling and any applicable sales taxes as these are paid by the buyer EX: Sweater sale price \$35.00 which buyer pays + \$5.00 Shipping and Handling. Consignment Merchant (Lyn's) pays \$28.00 to consignee (you). The remaining \$12.00 is split between shipping costs and related expenses (time and travel) and \$7.00 is held by Lyn's Fiber to Fabric in commission.

Explanation of the Consignment Sales Agreement and Lyn's Fiber to Fabric processes

CONSIGNMENT SELLER shall provide an accounting, under oath, or otherwise verified, every 30 Days to OWNER, each accounting being accompanied by payment in full for all sums due. Should any sums not be paid when due, then OWNER shall have the right, but not obligation, to repossess all merchandise of OWNER's in CONSIGNMENT SELLERS possession. All sums due, but unpaid, shall bear interest at the highest legal rate applicable.

This is one area of protection to you. Every 30 days Lyn's will provide you with a report of all sales completed to you the owner. At this time Lyn's will pay any and all sales that have occurred. If no sales have occurred Lyn's will request a pricing review. If Lyn's does not pay you for items sold within 30 days you can take back all other merchandise, expect payment in full and interest at the highest applicable rate possible. Honestly, we don't anticipate any problems with payments to our crafters. This is a standard protection to you in case something unexpected occurs.

Explanation of the Consignment Sales Agreement and Lyn's Fiber to Fabric processes

CONSIGNMENT SELLER shall permit an audit by representatives of the OWNER, of all of its books and records, together with a physical inspection of the premises and inventory of goods at such times as OWNER may desire.

CONSIGNMENT seller herewith grants a lien to OWNER in the proceeds of the sales of Owner's goods.

Another protection for you, audits will be accepted by your representatives. I will open the accounting records of Lyn's Fiber to Fabric to you, or your legal representatives for any reason what so ever. Additionally, you may inspect the storage area and goods on the premises of Lyn's Fiber to Fabric. A certain amount of trust is involved with our agreements. It is extremely important to Lyn's Fiber to Fabric that we start with an open book and open door policy. Lyn's Fiber to Fabric will not profit further than is indicated in this agreement. This service is provided to enhance your sales opportunities and profit from your craft or hobby. Our commission rate may change in the future depending on expenses and sales volumes. This business is for profit. However, neither underhanded or nefarious business practices will be practiced by Lyn's Fiber to Fabric. If you feel you are being dealt with in a manner contrary to this promise contact immediately the proper authorities.

Explanation of the Consignment Sales Agreement and Lyn's Fiber to Fabric processes

This agreement is for "sale or return." CONSIGNMENT SELLER shall have 180 days from the date of delivery of the consigned goods to either sell or pay for the goods, or return the same. Should CONSIGNMENT SELLER fail to pay or return the same within such time period, then the goods shall be deemed to be purchased by CONSIGNMENT SELLER, and shall be paid for within 10days days, net.

Freight for return shall be paid by the CONSIGNMENT SELLER. OWNER shall have the right to designate the carriers. The same shall be shipped insured for the value of the goods.

Final items, simply this section indicates that we agree to either sell or return the goods within 180 days (6 months). If Lyn's Fiber to Fabric does not sell your item, Lyn's can purchase it at the consigned price or return them. If Lyn's Fiber to Fabric does not return the item payment shall be made with in 10days. You the owner can choose how the item is returned, shipping and insurance will be paid by Lyn's Fiber to Fabric.

A blank form for your use follows this page. It can be this simple complete sign and date the agreement. Package your goods and, hit the Post Office! You will receive via email a copy of the agreement signed by me upon our receipt and acceptance of your crafted items.
